

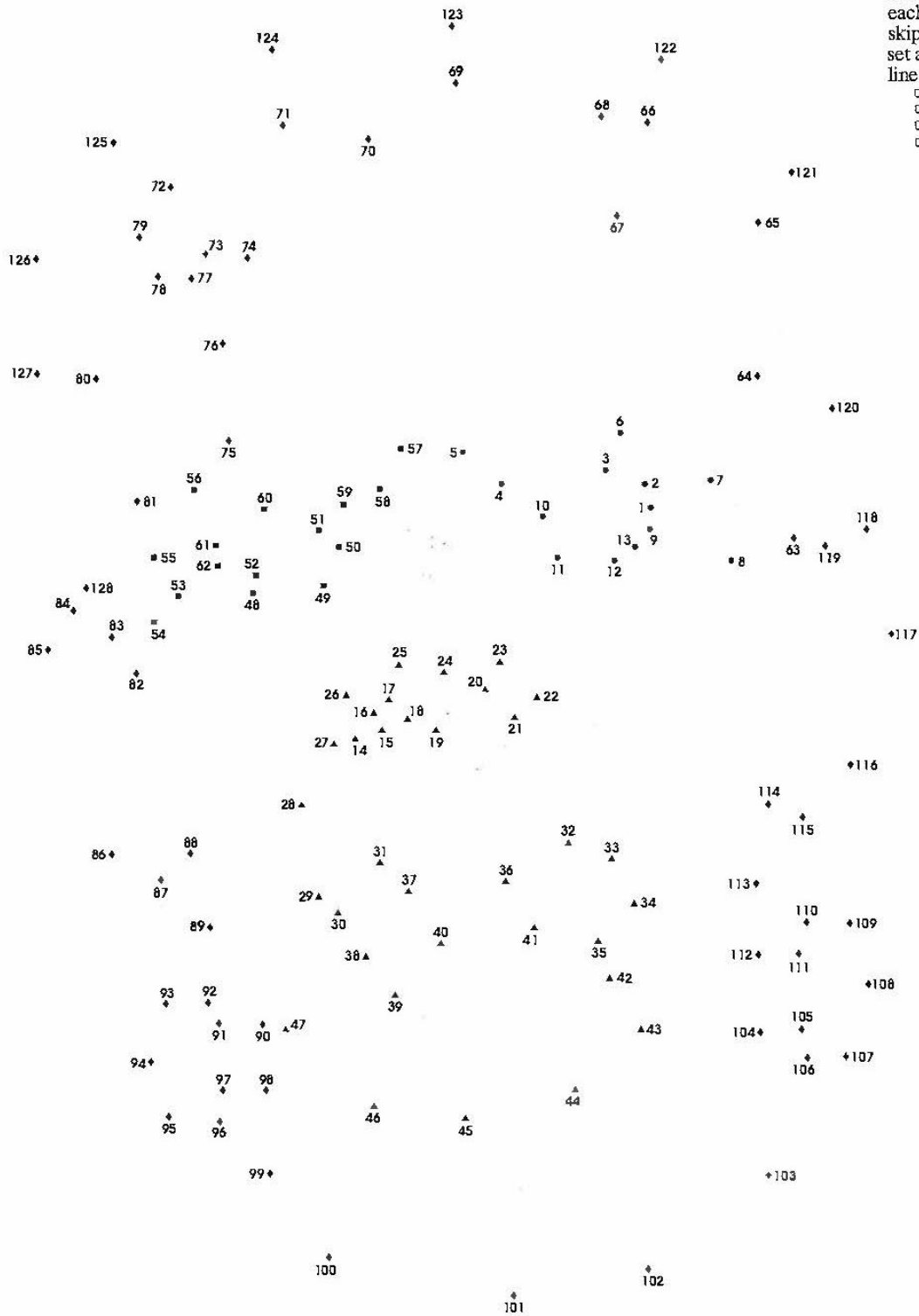

## Puzzle 4

A cryptogram is a type of puzzle where a piece of text has been encrypted using a simple substitution cipher. That means every letter in the real sentence (or in this case, quote) has been swapped for another letter of the alphabet. Letter substitutions remain constant throughout the quote. For instance, **XFO = THE** throughout this puzzle.

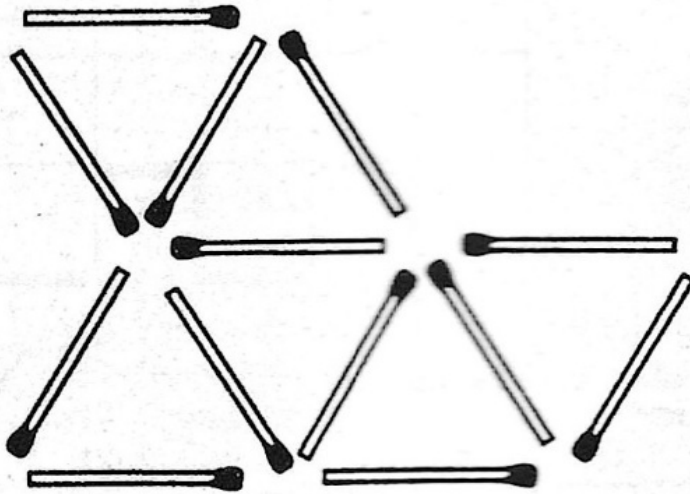

Remove three matches to leave three triangles.



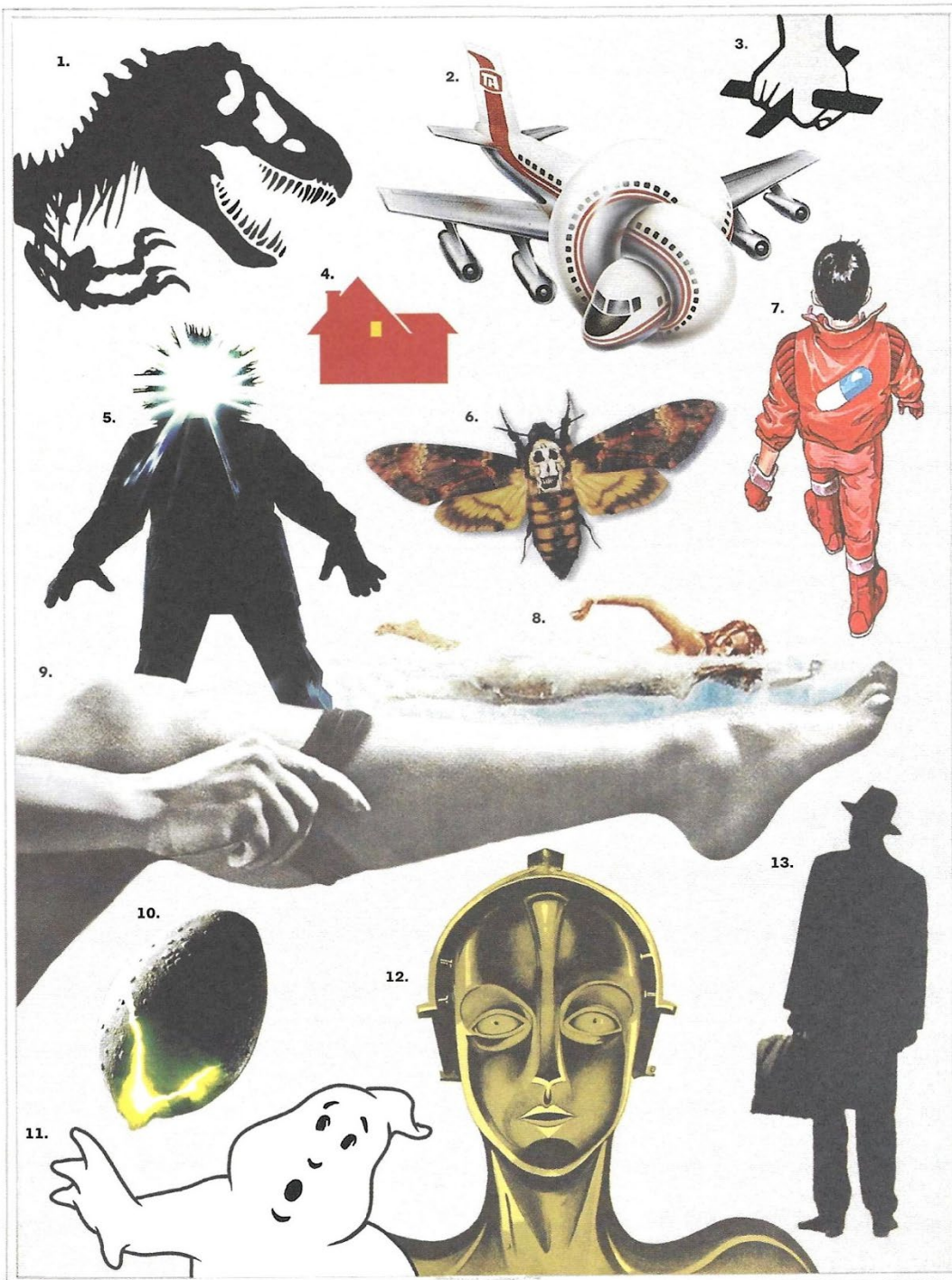

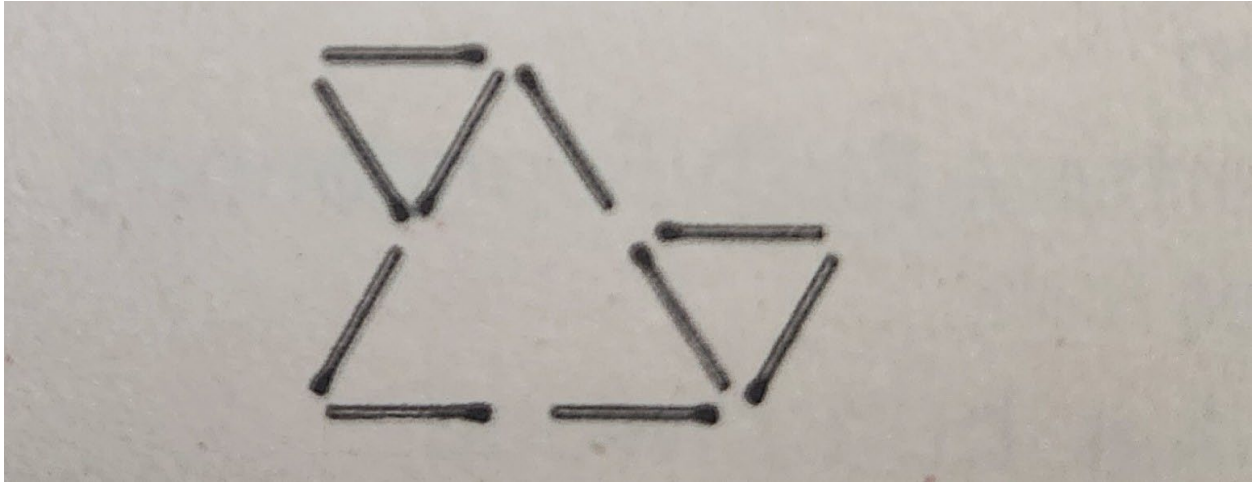
